Nutsa Gogaladze (b. 1998 in Tbilisi, Georgia) is a self-taught artist, illustrator and curator based in Tbilisi, Georgia. She received a BBA in finances from Georgian International University in 2020. In 2022, Gogaladze completed a non-formal master course in creative mediation at CCA (The Center of Contemporary Art) and founded the social project "March Gallery" to support older self-taught Georgian artists.

"My soft pastel works represent life impressions gained from personal experiences, telling stories of unforgettable beautiful sights. Recent pieces capture the dialogue between my inner-child and adult self, expressed through different symbols such as the playfulness of cats, lights, still lives and fallen petals..

I never know what I'm going to draw next, so this spontaneous process allows me to create unexpected compositions that wouldn't be possible with a planned approach"
